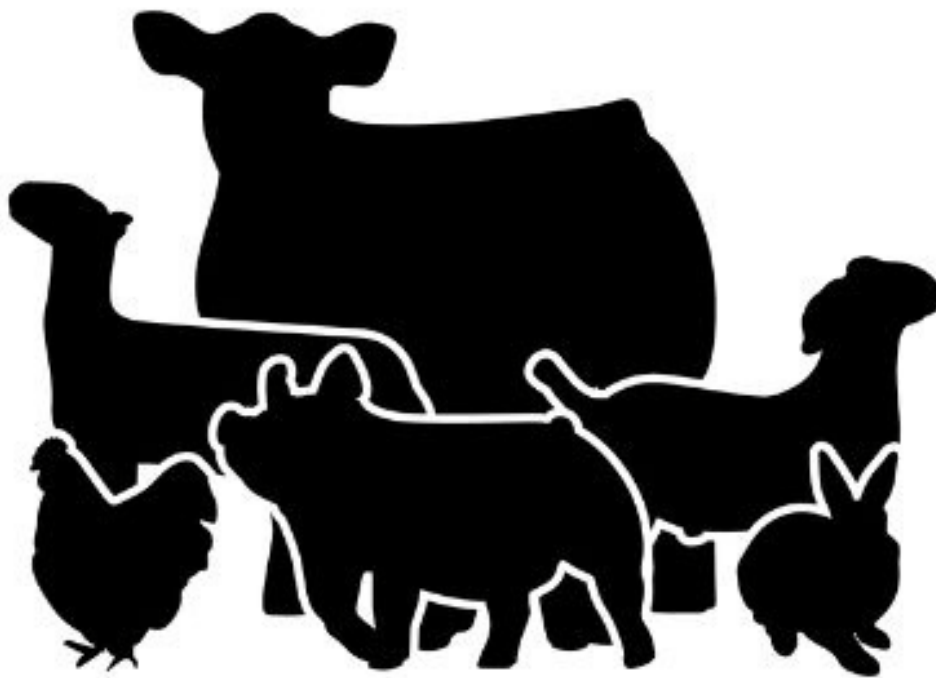

DID YOU SAY SAVE MONEY?

You can save almost \$773.40 when you purchase a Steer at the Sheridan County Youth Market Livestock Sale. And here is how: A market steer that weighs 1300 lbs. will have an average carcass yield of 62%. That means this steer will produce an 806 lbs. carcass. That carcass will then produce 639 pounds of take-home meat. From this 639 lbs. carcass you will end up with the following:

Cost to buy at the store:

369 pounds will be roasts and steaks @ average price of \$18.50/lb. = **\$6,826.50**

270 pounds will be ground beef and stew meat @ average price of \$8.97/lb. = **\$2,421.90**

Total Price at the store to buy a market steer = \$9,248.40

Cost to buy a 4-H/FFA Steer:

3 yr. avg. price of a steer at a local Junior Sale- \$5.75/lb.x 1300 lbs. = **\$7,475.00**

Price to have the animal butchered, cut and wrapped = **\$1,000.00**

Total Cost to BUYING LOCAL: \$8,475.00

For \$773.40 less than at the grocery store you can support a local 4-H/FFA member, local butcher and know where and how your food is raised.

Livestock Auction Bidding Process and Buyer Options

Beef, lambs and swine are sold on a per-pound basis and goats are sold per head. Feathers and fur are sold by the pen. The buyback prices are listed below.

Option A: You pay the full bid price and receive the meat. The animal is processed at the packer of your choice and packaged to your specifications. The cost of the processing is assumed by you, the buyer.

Option B: You pay the difference between your bid and the buyback price and you do not get the animal.

Example:	Bid:	\$2,000.00
	Buyback:	<u>\$1,012.00</u>
	You pay:	\$988.00

2026 Buy Back Prices:

Beef \$2.25/lb Swine \$1.25/lb Lambs \$2.35/lb Goats \$3.00/lb

There is a weight cap on the sale of animals as identified in your programs. You only pay on a max weight, anything over the weight is free to you! These caps are:

Beef 1400 lbs Swine 300 lbs Lambs 150 lbs

Option C: Donation- If you donate your animal, the animal can be processed at a federally/state inspected plant if you have arrangements made. If not then the animal will go to buy back and you will pay the full price. The money generated from the buyback will be sent to the charity.

Sale Order

The 2026 sale order is as follows:

The specie order begins with Swine, Beef, Lamb, Goat then Feathers.

- A section of random sort animals will start the sale of each specie.
- Class Winners of Market Animals from each class/specie sell first
- Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champions of each large animal species
- 2nd Place Class Winner Market Animals from each class/specie
- Overall Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Feathers and Fur
- Champion\Res. Champion Bred and Fed if not previously sold, then all remaining animals are sold based on a random sort.
